Safety Awareness Week: This coming week of September 30 - October 4, has been designated as "Safety Awareness Week" for the YCDSB. As part of our safety initiative at St. Thomas Aquinas, we will be practicing safety procedures with students and staff. During this week, we will be rehearsing a variety of emergency school procedures to acquaint students and staff with the precautionary steps to take in the event of such things as a warning of severe weather, or an intruder. In addition, throughout the year we will hold practice drills to acquaint students with various emergency protocols. Teachers will review these procedures with students in class prior to our practice drills.

National Day of Truth and Reconciliation: On Monday September 30, 2024, St. Thomas will commemorate the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation (Orange Shirt Day). Students will be involved in lessons and discussions within the classroom along with morning announcements and prayers. Staff and students are invited to wear Orange shirts on this day to acknowledge the impact of the residential school system, raise awareness and honour Indigenous communities, and to promote reconciliation.

Luke 4:18 Thanksgiving Food Drive: The Luke 4:18 Social Justice Committee is organizing a Thanksgiving food drive in support of the local food bank. Non-perishable food items (canned goods, cereals, granola bars, powdered milk etc.) are being collected from October 3rd to October 10th. Our school goal is to collect 350 non-perishable items.
