Student Entry:

- Supervision begins at 8:55 am. In order to maintain the safety of all students, parents/guardians are asked not to enter the playground between 8:55 am and 9:10 am. During inclement/indoor procedures students can directly enter into the school.
- Kindergarten students will continue with direct entry into their classroom using the main door by the Kiss 'N Ride. A staff member will be at the doors to assist students with entry to the classroom.
- Students arriving late must use the front/main school doors. Parents/Guardians must sign their child(ren) in with the office.

Bus Loop: The bus loop is at the front of the school building. Please do not enter the bus loop during morning entry (8:55 am - 9:10 am) and afternoon dismissal procedures (3:30 pm - 4:00 pm).

Parking Lot Safety: The safety of students, and staff is paramount at St. Thomas CES. The Kiss 'N Ride, located on the north end of the building acts as a drop off/pick up loop. We ask that parents/guardians not park/leave their vehicles unattended, use caution when in the parking lot and be mindful of students, families and staff

Safe Arrival: Parents and guardians are required to report their child(ren)'s absence or late arrival in advance, or before bell time for the current day by accessing the Elementary Safe Arrival Program using any of the three methods below:
