There are three different ways to donate:

Option #1: The community is strongly encouraged to utilize the York Catholic District School Board's on-line payment system for donations to the school at www.canadahelps.org. This is a safe and secure method to make an individual donation to the school through an on-line payment method and receive a tax receipt immediately.

Option #2: Individual pledge cheques of \$25 or more are eligible for a tax receipt through the board. These cheques will need to be made payable to York Catholic District School Board.

Option #3: Cash or Cheques. Cash or cheques under \$25.00 do not qualify for a tax receipt. If writing a cheque, please make it payable to St. Thomas Aquinas CES.
