Carnaval Presentation: St Thomas Aquinas CES recognizes the value of engaging external organizations and individuals to further enhance the classroom curriculum to support student engagement, achievement and well-being. On February 19, 2026, we will welcome Dr. Accordion from Prologue Performing Arts to our school. The "Dr. Accordion Carnaval Presentation" will be for all students as they learn about musical mindfulness; identifying their feelings and pairing them with music. With polyrhythmic clapping, and a live arranging session, musical decisions come to life in real-time. Featuring songs from Canada, Brazil, Bulgaria (and beyond!). Shrove Tuesday: Tuesday February 17, is Shrove Tuesday or Pancake Tuesday. It is often a day of celebration that marks the end of Ordinary time in the Liturgical Calendar. CSC is proud to host a pancake breakfast on this day for all students. Bus Loop & Kiss 'N Ride: The bus loop is at the front of the school building. Please do not enter the bus loop during morning entry (8:55 am - 9:10 am) and afternoon dismissal procedures (3:30 pm - 4:00 pm). The Kiss 'N Ride, located at the north end of the building, serves as a drop-off and pick-up loop. We kindly ask parents and guardians not to park, leave their vehicles unattended, or idle in this area. Please use caution in the parking lot and remain mindful of students, families, and staff.

With the addition of snow hills, the Kiss 'N Ride loop becomes narrower and more difficult to navigate. For this reason, families are asked not to stop before entering the loop or within the loop itself, as this creates a backlog of cars entering the parking lot area. If you are dropping off your child at the FDK doors, please drive all the way down toward the doors to allow for a smoother and quicker drop-off. *To ensure student safety, we strongly encourage all children to exit the vehicle on the sidewalk side.* Thank you for your continued support.
